The Stewards, having received a report (no.5) from the Race Director heard the driver Robert Theuil # 16 and driver Ervins Greins # 2 and having examines video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following

Competitor: Robert Theuil

Driver: 16 # Robert Theuil

Time (fact): 17:04

Session: Final

Fact: During Final car # 16 did not slow down after the double yellow flags were shown and overtook

no. 2

Offence: Breach of Article 2.5.5. b of the Appendix H of Fia ISC

Decision:

- 1. Driver no.2 will be classified 3th in final
- 2. Driver no.16 will be classified 4th in final

Reason: When the double yellow flag is waived the driver is obliged to reduce the speed significantly, not to overtake, and to be prepared to change direction or stop. There is a hazard wholly or party blocking the track and/or marshals working on or beside the track. The driver # no.16 did not respect this rule and overtook car # 2. The driver # 2 confirmed that he had a technical problem with the steering system and it was difficult for him to take left turns and this difficulty was harder lap by lap. That was the reason that he slowed down strongly in the last left corner what will be recognized as a technical failure. Taking this in consideration the Stewards decided as mentioned above

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of The Fia International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the Fia Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
