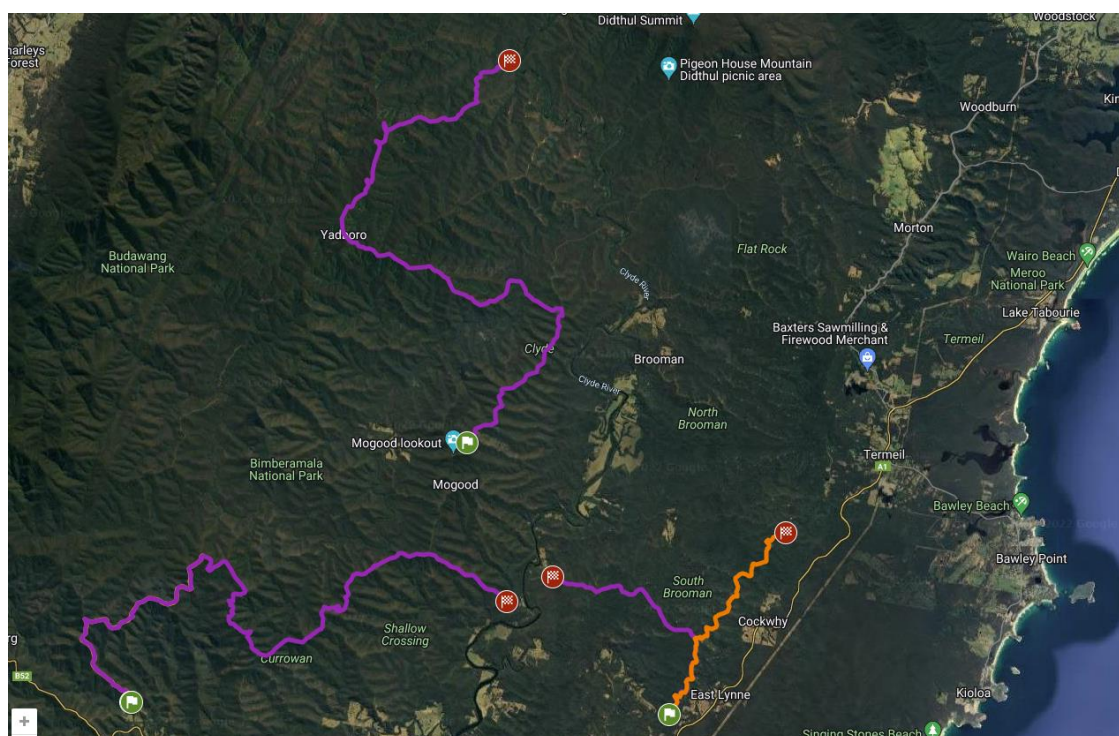

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SECTION 2: AREA DETERMINED BY THE PERMIT

Roads under the management of Shoalhaven City Council as shown by the information provided in the event application.

SECTION 3: ORGANISERS RIGHTS

The Organiser shall have the use of the area (hereinafter called "the reserve") shown on their course maps below:



SECTION 4: PERMIT PERIOD

The Permit Period is for 12th till 14th of August 2022 Council reserves the right to determine the Permit at any time without the prior notice to the organiser in the event of any breach by the organiser of any of the conditions of the permit.

SECTION 5: PERMIT FEE

As outlined in separate invoice.

SECTION 6: SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Valid insurance Certificate of Currency to a minimum of \$20 million, noting Shoalhaven City Council as an interested party must be maintained for the duration of the event.
2. This permit must be at the area being used and must be produced on demand.
3. Your organisation is liable for restoration of any damage resulting from these activities and the public reserve shall be left free of rubbish at the completion of activities.
4. This permit and use of the area is subject to compliance with any direction given by any authorised officer of Council, Council Ranger or a Police Officer in the course of his duty.
5. This approval does not include the exclusive use of the remainder of the public reserve by you/your organisation. Minimum inconvenience shall be caused to local residents and to other persons wishing to use the Public Reserve. The rights of the general public to use and have free and unrestricted access to the public reserve must be respected.
6. You/your organisation must accept responsibility for any claim which arises regarding damage or accidents which may occur during your occupation of the designated area.
7. Council may have underground services, eg, electricity and water mains, located within the bounds of this reserve. Stakes, star pickets, pegs, etc, are not to be driven without first consulting with Council for location of services within the reserve (Electricity - 4429 3233 // Water - 0412 125 964).
8. The Licensee shall not interfere with any other person authorised by Shoalhaven City Council to use the reserve or any part thereof.
9. Council reserves the right to cancel this permit immediately should such action be considered necessary.
10. The Licensee shall effect and maintain all other insurance as may be required by the Workers' Compensation Act or any other Act or Acts of Parliament in regard to the conduct of activities of the Licensee on the demised premises.
11. The service of alcohol is not permitted for this event.
12. Vehicular access to the Reserve is restricted to the time required to load and unload passengers or materials. No vehicle shall remain on the reserve except for this purpose. Vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas only. No vehicles are allowed access to the beach. Vehicle and crowd control remain the responsibility of your organisation.
13. Any fire restrictions that are in force during this period are to be adhered to. No fires are to be lit except in properly constructed fireplaces/barbecues and no trees are to be cut or lopped in any circumstances.

14. In the event that the reserve or area is subject to this permit being irrigated the permit holder is to check with Council's Parks Operations section to ensure that the irrigation system automatic switching is turned off.

15. Interference with the electrical wiring, switchboard or sound equipment at the facility, or any alteration to Council's property whatsoever without written approval shall result in the forfeiture of the bond and the hirer shall be liable to prosecution. The use of double adaptors is not permitted at any Council facility. All electrical appliances must be tested and carry a current tag. All electrical devices must be protected by an RCD.
