

## ACCREDITATION RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR “RALLY ELEKTRĒNAI BY AROMÁMA 2022”

The accreditation will be possible for:

- journalists;
- media photographers;
- TV/video cameramen;

1.2. Accreditation is not possible for advertising, marketing or public relations agencies, media representatives, who are not journalists. Team press persons will be accredited only if they provide examples of previous racing coverage. 1.3. Accreditation shall be provided only to media representatives of at least 18 years old.

1.4. Accredited journalists will be provided with all necessary documents and permissions for rally (tabards, if needed – for 20 euro deposit, that is returned when the tabard is returned). During the rally, all journalists will be able to use press centre in Draugystės st. 2, Elektrėnai, during 09-10<sup>th</sup> of September, 2022.

1.5. Decision about the accreditation is up to Organizers. For all material, journalists must use the full title of the event “Rally Elektrėnai by aromáma 2022” along with #rallyelektrenai .

## 2. “ RALLY ELEKTRĒNAI BY AROMÁMA 2022” MEDIA SAFETY RULES

2.1. Presence in the Race venue under the influence of alcohol or narcotics is strictly prohibited!

2.2. Accredited journalists, photographers and video operators shall observe all the instructions of track guards, stewards and the official persons of the rally at all times.

2.3. The accredited photographers, radio journalists and TV/video crew with the respective media tabards are entitled to enter special areas for media on the track. Detailed map will be issued during press conference. Though, they shall observe all the instructions of track safety personnel, stewards and the official persons of the Rally at all times.

2.4. Beware of moving vehicles! Your safety in the track or Service area depends only on you. Pay attention to the surrounding activities!

2.5. Avoid being too close to the rally cars in the service area! Do not disturb work of the mechanics around the cars! Do not disturb work of teams!

2.6. Avoid reclining against the rally cars as they may start sudden movement and some car parts may be fragile and/or hot. Avoid standing nearby fire-fighting, steward or ambulance cars as the above may start sudden movement without prior warning.

2.7. Choose the location in the track, which is as safe as possible. Be prepared to unusual situations or accidents in the track at all times! If you are in the vicinity of the track, follow activities in the track at all times.

2.8. In case it is necessary to review the working material (photos, videos, etc.), avoid doing it in the vicinity of the track. Choose safer place!

2.9. Breach of any of the Media Safety Rules may be reason for accreditation annulment and exclusion from the race.

2.10. By sending the filled-in Media Accreditation Application Form you shall confirm that you have got acquainted with the Media Accreditation Rules and the Media Safety Rules and shall resolve to fully comply with the above and take full responsibility for your action.
