The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Technical delegate (document No 6.8), have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Driver and car No: 63 Vasilije JAKSIC

Competitor: Vasilije JAKSIC

Time: 17:10

Session: Scrutineering after Race 2

Fact: The measured turbo inducer diameter (Article 4.2.15a of the Appendix 6 to the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship - Category 1) exceeds the value declared by the Competitor in the PF technical sheet. Simulating the new performance factor number, it does not change the Group (pf Group 4). The car of the same Competitor (Vasilije JAKSIC), was already not in compliance with its PF technical sheet during the event in St-Jean du Gard.

Offence: Breach of Article 4.2.15a of the Appendix 6 to the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship - Category 1.

Decision: A fine of €500 and to revoke the suspension of the fine of €250 decided by the Panel of the Stewards at the event in St-Jean du Gard.

In accordance with Article 12.8 of the FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.




Reason: Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the measured turbo inducer diameter of car 63 was exceeded the value declared by the Competitor and it was the second infringement of Article 4 of the Appendix 6 to the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship - Category 1 this season. In addition, being the second infringement of Article 4 of the Appendix 6 to the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship - Category 1 this

season, the Stewards determined that the conditions to revoke the suspension of the penalty (i.e. a fine of €250) decided by the panel of the Stewards at the event in St-Jean du Gard for an infringement of similar nature are met.

The Competitor is reminded that he has the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
