Each Competitor has to declare in what FIA Title he wants to score points by its each crew: - FIA WORLD CUP or FIA EUROPEAN CUP, by marking the dedicated checkbox in the entry form.

To score points in the FIA World Cup for Teams, competitors must register as "Team" with the FIA before the closing date for entries of the first Baja entered under a Team name by using the registration form which can be found on the FIA website: https://registrations.fia.com/rally

It is the responsibility of the competitor to fill out the entry form completely and correctly. Each competitor is obliged to indicate in the entry form a complete set of required data.

Correctly filled (with attached copy of competitors licence and confirmation of payment of the required entry fee) and approved, the entry form shall be automatically sent by electronic mail to the Rally Organizer and to the Competitor on his e-mail address, mentioned in his entry form.

In addition to the completed entry form, it is necessary to send color scan copies by e-mail to biuro@bajapoland.eu of below documents:

- competitors licence,

- all Crew members sport licences, as well as passports (for non-EU citizens) or national identification (only for EU citizens),

- ASN authorisation, for all foreign competitors and/or drivers (if not included in the sporting licences),
- all crew members appropriate driving licences,
- individual accident insurance of all crew members,
- road registration of entered vehicle,
- insurance of entered vehicle,
- FIA Technical Passport of entered vehicle,

- Certificate of entered vehicle ownership or written authorization from the owner, to use this entered vehicle in sporting competition during rally 2022 Columna Medica Baja Poland.

The competitor must provide during the OA the original entry form and any additional requests with signatures of the Competitor's representative and all crew members.

The Entry to the Rally is the conclusion of a civil law contract with the Organizer. It also means the consent of the Team / Competitor / Driver / Co-Driver for the processing of personal data for purposes related to the organization of the above Rally, and the whole series of Competitions in which the Rally is organized. This entry also means consent to the publication of Team / Competitor / Driver / CoDriver image and its/his/her results. A Team / Competitor / Driver / Co-Driver has the right to access its / his / her personal data, correct them and request to cease processing of these data. A request to cease processing of its / his / her personal data means resignation from participation in the Competition.

Art. 4.5 Payment

Any entry not accompanied by the entry fee shall be, according to Art. 3.9.3 of FIA International Sporting Code, null and void. The entry fee shall be paid by only by bank transfer to the account indicated below (in the latter case, adequate proof of payment must be attached to the entry form):

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place,
- to teams whose entry application is rejected.

The organiser may partially refund entry fees if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

Art. 5.1 Each Competitor, for each of his entered competing vehicle, must be in possession of a valid (throughout the whole duration of the Rally) public liability insurance policy (road traffic insurance) for owner of a car registered in country or abroad, according to appropriate law regulations and present it during the Administrative Checks. Casco insurance with sport extension is also recommended for all vehicles entered to Rally.

Art. 5.2 The entry fee includes the insurance premium to insure civil liability of entered Crews against third party risks whilst taking part in the 2022 Columna Medica Baja Poland. The insurance cover will come into effect from the Administrative Checks and Scrutineering for the Rally and include participation in the Shakedown.

Art. 5.3 The Competitors/Crew members must bear in mind that the insurance policy taken out via the Organizer covers only damage caused to third parties by the Organizer or the entered competing vehicles. Any damages and/or losses and/or harms caused by Competitors/Crew members to themselves or damage to competing vehicles participating in the Rally are not covered by this insurance policy.

Art. 5.4 The Competitors/Crew members are recommended to take information about the cover afforded by their competition driver's license and to take out a convenient and individual insurance on their own which they deem fit.

Art. 5.5 The entry fee does not include the insurance premium to insure civil liability (OC) of Competitors/Crews personnel and Competitors/Crews accompanying persons against all third parties and accident insurance (NNW) of Competitors, Crew members, Competitors/Crews personnel and Competitors/Crews accompanying persons.

Service vehicles and auxiliary vehicles, even those bearing special marks and plates issued by the Organizer, may never be considered as officially participating in the Rally. Therefore, they are not covered with the Rally insurance policy. The Competitors/Crews are solely responsible for their personnel and their accompanying persons and the organizer is not responsible for caused by them damages and / or losses and / or harms.

Art. 5.6 According to Polish Insurance Laws, the organizer is not responsible for any damages and/or losses and/or harms of Competitors and/or Crew members and/or members of Competitors/Crews personnel and/or Competitors/Crews accompanying persons, occurred during the Rally.

The Organizer shall not be liable for any accident caused to the Competitors/Crews and competing vehicles during the whole time of the Rally, in the case of catastrophe, cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism, etc..

The Competitors, Crew members, members of Competitors/Crews personnel and Competitors/Crews accompanying persons, must bear all consequences (damages, fines and penalties) of accidents created by them.

The Organizers also shall not be liable for any infringement of the Polish Laws and regulations. Each Competitor/Crew member takes part in the Rally at their own risk.

By signing of the Entry Form the Competitors and all Crew members, renounces all rights to enforce any compensation for any damages and/or losses and/or harms, which might be result of accidents occurred during the Rally to them and/or their personnel members and/or their accompanying persons and/or their equipment. This renouncement refers to FIA, PZM, the organizer, the rally officials and other Competitors and Crews (also from accompanying events run in the same time and on the same route).

Art. 5.7 In accordance with legal regulations, the Organizer has taken out a civil liability insurance policy of the Rally and accident insurance policy of the members of the Organizer personnel not covered by other insurance policy. The indemnity provided under the civil liability insurance policy of the Rally is: 18 000 000 PLN (approx. 3 500 000 EUR).

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

See Appendix 3 of these SR "Decals and positioning of supplementary advertising".

The organiser will provide each crew with the advertising and identification panels, which must be affixed to their vehicles in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. All stickers must be affixed to their designated vehicle during the whole rally (see also FIA CCRSR Art.19-20).

The final text of the Organisers obligatory and optional advertising, will be indicated in a Bulletin before the Rally.

Art. 6.1 Obligatory organiser's advertising

Art. 6.3 Limitations

Any advertising of cigarettes, tobacco products, betting and alcohol beverages is prohibited in Poland. All rights are reserved for the Organizer to place advertisement in Rally Office, at Ceremonial Start and Prize Giving Ceremony of the Rally, in Service Park and along the itinerary of the competition.

Within the entry fee the Competitors may display its advertising on their competing vehicles, service vehicles, auxiliary vehicles, service tents, umbrellas, fences surrounding their service space, etc. located on service position allocated to the Competitors. Other marketing and advertising activity must be agreed with the Organizer.

Art. 7. Tyres

Art. 7.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the event

See Art. 10 of the FIA CCRSR and Art. 10 of Appendix V2 of the FIA CCRSR.

The number of tyres to be used by FIA T1 Priority drivers is 10.

Art. 8. Fuel

Art. 8.1 Technical Requirements

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (Art. 57 of the FIA CCRSR).

Art. 8.2 Range

Each Competitor / Crew is responsible for calculating the appropriate amount of fuel for his vehicle.

In any case, the Competitor / Crew can't make claims against the organizer of the Rally if his vehicle does not cover the minimum distance between two refuelling points, indicated in the Itinerary and Road Book.

Art. 8.3 Ordering procedure / availability

There is no ordering fuel for the rally by the organiser or supplier designated by the organiser. Each competitor must provide the required fuel by its own in designated refuelling zones (RZ) and/or use only fuel available on commercial fuel stations indicated in the Road Book. According to article 55.1.1 of 2022 FIA CCR SR the list of commercial filling stations will be published no later than 24 hours before the start of each Leg.

Art. 8.4 Rules for refuelling

See Art. 55, 56, 57 of the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 9. Administrative checks

Art. 9.1 Documents to be presented:

To minimize the time required for Administrative Checks, competitor are required to send a photo (.JPG) or scan copies (.PDF) of the documents required below, and send them to the following email address biuro@bajapoland.eu:

- Valid competitors' licence.
- Valid driver's and co-driver's competition licences (if one of the drivers should be the competitor, he must hold also a valid competitors' licence).
- Valid driver's and co-driver's ID cards(only UE citizens)/passports (non-EU citizens).
- Valid driver's and co-driver's driving licences valid for the vehicle entered.
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required and not included in the licence).
- Completion of all details on the entry form.
- Valid entered vehicle road registration papers.
- Valid document of required civil liability insurance policy of entered vehicle (Art. 5.1 of these SR's).
- Certificate of entered competing vehicle ownership or the vehicle owner's consent to its participation in the 2022 Columna Medica Baja Poland rally.
- FIA Technical Passport with number (TT-XX-XXX).
- Amaury Sport Organisation (ASO) Technical Passport only for vehicles of groups T2 and T4 (if issued).

During Administrative Checks and Collection of Materials and Documents on days 1-2.09.2022 in Rally HQ, competitors must deliver original, correctly fully filled and signed entry form and show all required documents (originals) already send by email (if they will be asked to do so).

Art. 9.2 Timetable

See programme (SR Art. 3)

Detailed timetable of Administrative Checks and Collection of Materials and Documents will be published by a Bulletin before the Rally.

There will be established a Time Control (C1) before the Administrative Checks, which will be responsible for checking the Competitors' compliance with the assigned schedule.

Any delay at Time Control (C1) will result in administrative penalties:

• The first 15' of delay: 50 EUR.

- From 16' up to 1 hour of delay: 100 EUR
- Every following hour or fraction of delay: 100 EUR for each hour started.

Art. 10. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

See Article 23 and Article 24 of the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 10.1 Scrutineering, venue, and time

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team. See programme (SR Art. 3).

Detailed timetable of Scrutineering will be published by a Bulletin before the Rally.

There will be established a Time Control (C2) before the Scrutineering, which will be responsible for checking the Competitors' compliance with the assigned schedule.

Any delay at Time Control (C2) will result in administrative penalties:

- The first 15' of delay: 50 EUR.
- From 16' up to 1 hour of delay: 100 EUR
- Every following hour or fraction of delay: 100 EUR for each hour started.

Before scrutineering, vehicles and competitors must comply with the following:

- All rally plates, competition numbers and advertising plates must be correctly fitted in the entered vehicle,
- Sealing holes must have been drilled and the sealing wires must be ready in place,
- Complete Safety Tracking system unit must be correctly fitted in the entered vehicle.

Art. 10.2 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete original FIA Homologation Document (if applicable)
- FIA Technical Passport / ASO Technical Passport
- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

Entered vehicle registration & insurance documents, together with other necessary certifications/documents related to entered vehicle required equipment, must be available both for Scrutineering and Final Checks.

The installation of the Safety Tracking system will be checked at Scrutineering.

Art. 10.3 Mud flaps

According to Art. 25.3.4 of the FIA CCRSR mud flaps, in compliance with the Appendix J Art. 283-19, must always be in place and efficient.

Art. 10.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

The cars must be equipped with the medical kit according to FIA CCRSR Appendix III-1 and FIA Technical List n°83 and the survival kit according to FIA CCRSR Appendix III-2.1 and the defined Safety Type (see SR Art. 1.5).

(According article 1.5 of these SR's, this Rally is a Safety Type B).

Art. 10.5 Installation of the Safety Tracking System and Navigation System

Art. 10.5.1 Tracking System

All vehicles must only be fitted with the GEOTRAQ Safety Tracking System provided by RBI Sport - company designated by the Organiser.

GEOTRAQ safety system elements will be delivered to crews during Administrative Checks and Collection of Materials and Documents and must be mounted by crews before Scrutineering.

Correct mounting and system operation will be checked by members of GEOTRAQ service team, during the Scrutineering.

The rent fee for the GEOTRAQ Safety System unit is included in the entry fee.

The cost of mounting kit for the GEOTRAQ Safety System unit is not included in the entry fee, as competitors must pay 50 EUR for the kit during the Administrative Checks and Collection of Materials and Documents. The mounting kit remains the property of the competitor after buying.

Each Crew must also pay to the organizer 350 EUR of <u>refundable deposit</u> for each complete GEOTRAQ safety system set, which will be returned upon return of undamaged and complete set.

Returning of the complete GEOTRAQ safety system set will be at the entrance of Final Parc Fermé D on Sunday, 4th of September or at Rally HQ in case of withdrawal.

The system manual is presented in Appendix 5 to SR.

Art. 10.5.2 Navigation System (NAV-GPS)

GEOTRAQ Safety system will be used as official NAV-GPS to control the Speed Control Zones, Passage Controls and Waypoints (without navigations function).

Art. 10.5.3 Connection of the Systems (FIA CCRSR Art. 12.3)

The specifications for the standard power connector are laid down in the FIA CCRSR Appendix VI.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the GEOTRAQ Safety system always remain permanently connected and switched on with the antenna connected throughout the duration of the whole competition.

Art. 10.5.4 FIA GPS Data Logger

Vehicles selected by the FIA after the publication of the entry list may be equipped with an FIA GPS Data Logger to monitor their performances during the event. For more check art. 13.1.1 of 2022 FIA CCR SR.

Art. 10.5.5 FIA Accident Data Recorder (ADR)

For more check art. 13.2 of 2022 FIA CCR SR.

Art. 10.5.6 FIA On-Board Surveillance Camera (FIA OBSC)

Vehicles selected by the FIA may be equipped with an FIA OBSC to monitor all activities inside the vehicle during the event. For more check art. 13.3 of 2022 FIA CCR SR.

Art. 10.6 On-Board Cameras

Each Competitor must:

- Send the request for using on-board cameras on e-mail: biuro@bajapoland.eu before 26th of August 2022;
- indicate Competitor's name, car number, competitor's address and use of recorded footage;
- provide all recordings at the end of each Section if requested to do so by Organiser or Officials;
- pay a penalty of € 500,00 in case of nonrespect of the above rules.

This equipment MUST be presented and approved at Scrutineering and at each time when modification will be made during the competition and must comply with art. 11 of the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 10.7 Electronic Equipment

Any radio or electronic means of communication, or any other device not expressly permitted in FIA CCRSR regulations is forbidden on board the vehicles.

Any numbers of telephones, mobile phones or satellite phones carried on board must be given in the entry form or as the latest to the Organiser during the Administrative Checks.

Art. 11. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 11.1 Drivers' Briefing(s)

Team managers and/or Drivers' briefing before start of the Rally will be held in presence in accordance to Rally Programme (SR Art. 3).

Organiser may organize additional Team managers and/or Drivers' briefings during the rally if it deems this to be appropriate

Additional necessary information's will be provided on-line via DNB.

Art. 11.2 Pre-Start Area

On the day of the Ceremonial Start, the Pre-Start Park Fermé A shall be suited for all Crews. 02.04.2022 / Friday / from 16:30 "Szczecin Service Park Krzekowo-Bezrzecze / Zawadzkiego-Klonowica, 71 Szeroka street, 71-211 Szczecin".

Each entered competing vehicle must report in Pre-Start Park Fermé A on 02.04.2022 / Friday / up to 16:30.

Members of Competitors/Crews team personnel are allowed to put entered competing vehicle into the Pre-Start Park Fermé A.

A penalty for late appearance at the Pre-Start Park Fermé A entry control point in relation to the scheduled time will be 100 EUR.

After entry to Pre-Start Park Fermé A crews nominated by the Organiser must take part in Pre -Rally Press Conference, located in Szczecin Service Park.

Art. 11.3 Official Rally Start / Ceremonial Start, procedures and order

Rally Start is also the start of Leg 1 - Section 1.

Starting order to Rally Start will take place according to Starting List to Leg 1.

The Ceremonial Start will be run as a passage of each Crew through the presentation ramp, which will be set close to TC 0. All Crews are obliged to move according to Road Book and instruction given by marshals and Organizer personnel.

Art. 11.4 Electronic start procedure at Selective Sections

At each Start, there will be 2-digit electronic starting device with 2 green lights, coupled with a photocell responsible for detection of false starts.

The photocell will be placed 50 cm beyond the start line. The display will be placed so to be well visible to a Crew sitting in a vehicle on the starting line.

The vehicle with the Crew is placed at the start line. The starting device continuously counts down to the moment of the green light. Numbers are shown in the sequence: 30, 15, 10, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 and the green light.

The green light will stay on for 20 seconds. Within this time, a Crew must start.

Art. 11.5 Qualifying Stage (QS)

Art. 11.5.1 Any reconnaissance with the QS route is prohibited! (See SR App. No 6).

Art. 11.5.2 Starting order and intervals will be the same as for Rally Start (TC0). The first Crew from national competitions (FIA-CEZ, RMPST, DDMC, MMCR, RPPST and Baja Poland Series) will start after the last Crew from the FIA World & European Cup for Cross Country Bajas competition.

Art. 11.5.3 The maximum time to finish the QS is 15 minutes.

Art. 11.5.4 Any competitor who, having started the QS fails to complete it as required by the regulations, will be given a penalty of the maximum time for the QS in addition to 50% of this maximum time.

Any competitor not having started the QS will be given a penalty of twice the maximum time for the QS, with a minimum of a one-hour penalty.

Art. 11.6 Finish procedures

After entry to Regrouping before the Podium Ceremony / Prize Giving (TC 5A) crews nominated by the Organiser must take part in Post-Rally Press Conference, located in Szczecin Netto Arena – Szafera street.

Prize giving ceremony will be held on 04.09.2022 / Sunday / at 14.30, after Regrouping Out TC 5B and before final Parc Fermé In TC 5C, next to Rally HQ building, located in Szczecin Netto Arena – Szafera street.

Each Crew member is obliged to behave in a proper manner during the Rally, personally participate in the award ceremony and if receiving an award be clothed in sporting suit, i.e. overalls buttoned up and shoes complying with the provisions of automobile sport.

Art. 11.7 Permitted early Check-in

An early check-in is allowed on all TC's located at the entry to Parc Fermé.

Art. 11.8 Official time used during the rally

The official Rally time will be communicated via GPS. Polish time = UTC/GMT+2 – summer time - Central European Time [CET]). The time measurement accuracy of the SS is 1 second.

Art. 11.9 Road Books delivery

Each Crew will be able to collect their Road Book for the present day at the entrance to Parc Fermé from: 30 minutes before their target time at Parc Fermé A - Out– TC 0 30 minutes before their target time at Parc Fermé B - Out – TC 1C

30 minutes before their target time at Parc Fermé C - Out – TC 3D

Art. 11.10 Servicing of vehicles

From TC 0 onwards, service of a entered competing vehicle may be carried out in Service Areas (Service Parks/Zones and Bivouacs) and road sections as permitted under the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 11.10.1 Servicing on Selective Sections

Service and assistance during the Selective Section running is allowed only in case: - by the crews of a vehicles entered and still in the FIA World Cup or FIA European Cup competition, and using the equipment on board of these vehicles,

- servicing, pushing or towing done by marshals/organization vehicles.

Art. 11.11 Special procedures / Organiser's activities

Art. 11.11.1 Special Stages (SS)

Art. 11.11.1.a Any reconnaissance with the SS's route is prohibited! (See SR App. No 6).

Art. 11.11.1.b The maximum time to finish the SS is: SS 2/3 – 4 hours 30 minutes SS 4/5 – 40 minutes

Art. 11.11.1.c The maximum driving time to finish the SS may be modified at the request of the Clerk of the Course by the Stewards of the Meeting. The Competitors/Crews will be notified of any such modification as soon as possible. Crew that exceed the maximum time to finish the SS is obliged to leave the SS route through the first available evacuation route. About the above fact the Crew will be informed at the first SOS point encountered along the SS route. Failure to comply with this provision will result in disqualification the Crew from the Rally.

Art. 11.11.1.d Fixed penalties for each SS

On Crews who for any reason have not started to SS, have not completed (finished) SS or exceeded maximum time to finish SS, fixed penalties will be imposed according to the rules below:

- any competitor who, having started a Special Stage, fails to complete it as required by the regulations, will be given a penalty of the maximum time for the Special Stage concerned in addition to 50% of this maximum time;

- any competitor not having started a Special Stage will be given a penalty of twice the maximum time for the Special Stage concerned, with a minimum of 4 hour penalty.

Art. 11.11.2 Time controls (TC), Passage Controls (PC) and Waypoints (WP)

Art. 11.11.2.a Target times in a Road Section between two Control Points are indicated in Rally Itinerary – Appendix 1 to these SR`s.

Art. 11.11.2.b PC`s will be marked only in Road Book and/or using physical signs.

Art. 11.11.2.c Each missed TC and/or PC and/or WP will be penalized in accordance to FIA CCRSR rules.

Art. 11.11.3 Speed Control Zones (SCZ)


Speed Control Zones (SCZ) might be established on SS route. The start of the SCZ will be indicated in the Road Book by an "DZ" symbol in circle filed orange color and by an "DZ" waypoint.

The end of the speed control zone will be indicated in the Road Book by an "FZ" symbol in circle filed green color and by an "FZ" www.maint

waypoint.

90 metres before and after waypoint "DZ" and 90 metres before and after waypoint "FZ , is the tolerance zone, where no penalty is applied.

Art. 11.11.4 Service Parks/Zones/Parc Fermé

The Service Park / and Remote Service Zone will be a Bivouac as defined by article 2.4 and articles 50, 51 and 52 of 2022 FIA CCR SR.

The speed of vehicles in the Service Parks / Zones may not exceed 30 kph.

Art. 11.11.4.a Service Parks/Zones Location

During the Rally, the Service Park will be located in:

- Szczecin Krzekowo-Bezrzecze / Zawadzkiego-Klonowica, 71 Szeroka street, 71-211 Szczecin (Service A, Service D).

Area of Military Shooting Range near Szafera street. Entrance via Szeroka Street from the traffic circle at Szafera, Modra and Szeroka Streets.

GPS location points:

53° 27.480'N 14° 29.266'E

During the Rally there will be one **Remote Service Zone**, which will be located in:

- "Remote Service Zone – Drawsko Pomorskie", Drawsko Pomorskie Military Training Ground - PĆT Bucierz:/ (Service B, Service C).

Area of Tactical Training Range Bucierz near Yellow Tower. Entrance via national route No 175 and village Mielenko Drawskie.

During the Shakedown period, the Service Park will be located in:

Art. 11.11.4.b Entry of service vehicles

Access to the Bivouac/Service Park/Service Zone will only be permitted for vehicles, identified by the Organizer, showing the Service Plates, provided by the Organizer at the Administrative Checks.

Auxiliary cars can enter the Service Parks only by purchasing a 50 EUR sticker at the Administrative Checks.

Service cars may enter the Remote Service Zone no later than one hour before the scheduled entry time of the 1st Crew.

Art. 11.11.8 Parc Fermé (PF) locations and numbers

The following PF's will be arrange during the rally:

- Parc Fermé "A" on 02.09.2022 - PF before the Rally Start - Szczecin - Jasne Błonia Square,

- Parc Fermé "B" on 02-03.09.2022 - overnight PF before Leg 1 - Section 2 - Szczecin Service Park,

- Parc Fermé "C" on 03-04.09.2022 - overnight PF before Leg 2 – Szczecin Service Park,

- Parc Fermé "D" on 04.09.2022 – PF after the Rally Finish - Szczecin Service Park.

Art. 11.11.9 Re-start after retirement

Any Crew, which has failed to complete a Section (exceed SS maximum time or exceed TC`s/PC`s maximum permitted lateness or not start to SS) will be assumed to re-start the Rally from the start of the next Section, unless they confirm otherwise in writing to the Clerk of the Course.

To re-start the Rally from the next Section, concerned Crew must put the vehicle to the Regrouping before the start of the next Section e.g. in the scheduled Check-out time from the Regrouping of the first Crew from their classification (FIA World Cup or FIA European Cup) in which this crew is classified. For overnight Regrouping (Parc Fermé) see rules of Art. 34.3.1 FIA CCRSR.

Art. 11.11.10 Time Cards

A new Time Cards will be delivered to every Crew at the start of each Section of a Leg. Used Time Cards will be collected at the end of each Section of a Leg.

If a Crew retires a Section of a Leg, they must return the Time Card at the closest control point.

If a Crew withdrawal from the Rally, they must return the Time Card at the closest control point, together with filled and signed Withdrawal Card (available at the end of the Roadbook).

Art. 11.11.11 Shakedown requirements

Only vehicles and crews that have fully and successfully completed the Administrative Checks and Scrutineering may take part in the Shakedown. For other rules see Art. 29 of FIA CCRSR.

Art. 11.11.12 Availability of participants

Competitors and Crew members who parked their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the Final Classification have been posted.

Art. 11.11.13 Special national requirements

All Competitors, Crew members and their accompanying persons are obliged to obey the:

- National Traffic Laws of Poland;

- and other applicable regulations.

Art. 13. Prizes

Art. 13.1 Classifications

The Final Classification will not be distributed after the Rally. The final classification will be published on the DNB on official rally website <u>www.bajapoland.eu</u> and also accessible in "Sportity" application in mobile devices (password **22CMBPFIA**).

Art. 13.2 Trophies

1st to 3rd place in the General Classification – 2 trophies per Crew, 4th to 5th place in the General Classification – 2 trophies per Crew, 1st to 3rd place in the Classification of each Group – 2 trophies per Crew, 1st place in Team Classification (T1, T2) – 1 trophy, 1st place in Team Classification (T4) – 1 trophy.

Art. 14. Final checks



Appendix 4 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements.

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) <u>as well as concerning</u> the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 48.1.

<u>REMEMBER: Wear of clothes complying with the FIA standard 8856-2018 is mandatory for all FIA priority drivers (and their codriver).</u>

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.

MEDICAL AND SURVIVAL KIT (Appendix III of the Cross-County Rally Sporting Regulations)

A sealed and valid Medical kit in accordance with the Specification for Cross Country Rallies and Bajas (Technical List n°83) must be placed inside the cockpit. The minimum weight must comply with Technical List n°83.

Appendix 5 Safety Tracking System / Car-to-Car Communication System

1. The GEOTRAQ Safety System elements will be delivered to crews during Administrative Checks and Collection of Materials and Documents and must be mounted by crews before Scrutineering.

Correct mounting and system operation will be checked by members of GEOTRAQ service team, during the Scrutineering.

2. The GEOTRAQ Safety System unit and accessories are owned by RBI Sport and will be removed after the end of the Rally.

Returning of the complete GEOTRAQ safety system set will be at the entrance of Final Parc Fermé C on Sunday, 4th of September or at Rally HQ in case of withdrawal.

3. The Competitor will be authorized to get a refund of return deposit after giving back complete, undamaged and in working order complete set of GEOTRAQ Safety System unit and accessories.

- 4. GEOTRAQ Safety System includes below tracking/safety functions:
 - GSM/GPRS Tracking;
 - manual and automatic stopped vehicle alert to Rally Control;
 - SOS/OK safety alerts to Rally Control;
 - two-way communication to Rally Control;
 - live tracking data interface available for rally website/mobile devices.

5. GEOTRAQ Safety System includes below NAV-GPS functions:

- validation by waypoints of the start and end of speed control zones,
- maximum speed control (for all vehicles on Special Stages and Road Sections),
- virtual WP/PC control.

6. GEOTRAQ Safety System includes below Vehicle-to-Vehicle Communication System functions:

- overtaking requests by vehicle-to-vehicle communication
- stopped vehicle in front alarm;
- vehicle-to-vehicle collision alarm;
- sound emission for alarms.

7. Manual of GEOTRAQ Safety System is available on DNB.
